## **LEGISLATIVE UPDATE**

Lieutenant Governor Dan Patrick has laid out his legislative priorities, among them are:

**Property Tax Reform** – Texans pay the sixth highest property taxes in the nation and the high rates are taxing people out of their homes and hampering business growth. This must change.

**School Choice** – There is broad support for legislation to ensure that every parent has the option to send their child to the school they believe is best for them.

**Sanctuary Cities** – No city in Texas should be allowed to ignore the law. We will end this practice once and for all this session.

**Photo Voter ID** – Nothing is more critical to our democracy than the integrity of the voting process. Photo Voter ID is essential.

**Women's Privacy Act** – A majority of Texans in both political parties and in every ethnic and demographic group believe that women and girls should have privacy and safety in their restrooms, showers and locker rooms. Unfortunately, legislation is necessary to assure that they do.

**Fetal Tissue/Partial Birth Abortion** – We will continue to fight to protect the dignity and sanctity of life by increasing criminal penalties for buying or selling human fetal tissue, among other protections, and we will ban partial birth abortion in Texas.

**TIME TO CELEBRATE – WE WON!!!**

AUSTIN, Texas (AP) — The U.S. Justice Department said Monday it is abandoning its longstanding opposition to a key aspect of Texas' toughest-in-the-nation voter ID law, costing voting rights groups their most important ally and possibly encouraging other conservative states to toughen their own election rules with President Donald Trump in charge.

In a filing Monday, the Justice Department said it was dropping its claim that Texas' measure was crafted with the purpose of disenfranchising minority voters because state lawmakers are considering a proposal to revise the law. The Republican-backed bill would make-permanent the court-ordered changes imposed for the November election, but its fate won't be known until closer to the end of Texas' legislative session in May.

Under Obama, the Justice Department sought to contest such measures, but the Trump administration's change in strategy could empower other conservative-controlled states to follow Texas' lead and tighten their voter ID rules.

And during his confirmation hearing last month, Sessions defended laws requiring voters to show picture identification at the polls: **"I think voter ID laws, properly drafted, are OK."**
