

LEGISLATIVE UPDATE – Michele Hercules

I truly believe there is a bright change coming to the Texas Capitol!

Border: According to Michael Banks, Texas Border Czar, 75% of all border crossings are happening in other states, not Texas. The recent efforts are working. SB4 which passed last session allowing law enforcement to arrest and deport anyone crossing our border illegally is back and forth between the courts, but the consensus is that Texas will prevail. Tom Homan, the former head of ICE has promised, that if President Trump wins, he (Homan) will head up the biggest mass deportation effort we have ever seen.

Education: Governor Abbott prevailed at the polls in his fight to bring school choice to Texas families! Texas Republicans voted 87% in favor of allowing the funding to follow the child in 2022. Next year, with the support of new legislators, Texas will join the majority of other states in passing school choice for our students and families.
